High School Mission Trip - July 13-20: Navajo Christian Foundation, Dilkon AZ

Our mission will be assisting in youth ministry, children's ministry, putting on a VBS for the Dilkon community and assisting with projects on the Navajo Christian Foundation Campus. Students will be immersed in the Navajo culture and have an opportunity to visit Canyon De Chelly. The distance from Modesto to Dilkon is 777 miles and requires a full day of travel. (a great time to bond with students). We memorize 1 Corinthians 13, *the whole chapter*, during this trip. Students will also be given some intentional down time to spend in God's Word. The beautiful landscape offers a wonderful backdrop of God's majesty



The entire cost of the mission trip is \$475.00 (includes all lodging, meals, transportation, sightseeing and incidentals)

Last year 3 students participated. This year we hope to have 6 students on the mission trip.
